**Minutes of Heck Extraordinary Annual Parish Meeting held on Monday 17/06/19 in the Parish Room, Great Heck at 19:00.**

## Agenda

**Pre-meeting. Attendance book** – all present signed the attendance book

**APM1901. Election of person to chair the Annual Parish Meeting** – if the current Chairman or vice-chairman of the parish council is not in attendance. – Cllr Watkinson-Teo proposed by Cllr Lumb and seconded by Cllr Wright. Election of vice-chairman Wright proposed by Cllr Watkinson-Teo and seconded by Cllr Lumb

**APM1902. Chairman to welcome councillors and members of the public.**

**APM1903. Apologies** – none received

**APM1904 – Co-option of new councillors** – the two new councillors were welcomed officially. Cllr H Benson-Collinson and Cllr G Mycroft completed the paperwork for the clerk to hand in to Democratic Services.

**APM1905. Minutes of previous APM** – agreed and signed at previous meeting

**APM1906. To receive report of parish council activities since last APM.** – to be given by the current chairman, if present, or vice-chairman or a councillor. The Chairman presented her report to the council – see attached. Additional issues were a continuation of the planning application for block building at Brocklesby's. The council discussed the issues and resolved to make the following observations: there are already block making factories within the village and the village is too small and rural to take on an additional block making facility – Sellite, CPM, Celcon and Plasmor, environmental issues regarding increased dust levels in the village leading to health issues for the residents. Concerns raised regarding potential increased emissions should a fire arise. Concerns regarding whether the owners of the site would take the opportunity to dispose of the waste pile via the

biomass, some of the materials are known to have carcinogenic properties. Access and exit to the site would be expanded, increased traffic from HGVs to and from the site and the current roads not being suitable for large numbers of HGV vehicles, no consultation with the local community with the 2 names cited no longer existing as businesses. Conclusion being that the council felt very strongly that no permission should be considered before the existing waste had been cleared. **Action clerk to invite local police officers to the September meeting.** The chairman has also raised the issues of footpath repairs and access to the play area, there is a plan for representatives of the council to assess the footpaths and take photographs. Discussion of speed limits within the village and one of the recent HGV counts showed 30 vehicles breaking the time restrictions. New tenants of the Bay Horse have been welcomed to the village. The summer fete has been cancelled but the harvest festival is still planned to take place. The litter pick organised by Heck Ladies was very successful with a further session planned for the Autumn, thanks to Cllr Wright for obtaining the equipment.

**APM1908. Electors present at meeting to raise any queries previously given to the clerk** – for information; the parish council to take note of any points raised. None present.
