- Letter dated 31st October 2016 received from Selby District Council regarding siting of a caravan. No action needed till further notification from SDC.
- Letter received from Mammoth Rentals Ltd to terminate rental of the three gardens on Green Lane from the Parish effective January 2017.
- Parish Councillors wish to review grass cutting service and requested for copy of existing contract with contractor. Action: JL to request from MF.
- Agreed by all to offer the new Parish Clerk 2 hrs per week at £9.054 per hour. Interview date confirmed on Monday, 12th December at 7 pm in the Parish Room.
- Snaith and Cowick Town Mayor is working with all surrounding Parishes to apply for LEP funding for a possible new route to stop HGVs going through villages. He requested for all Parish Councils including Heck to propose to our Ward Councillor, Cllr Debbie White to address the Cabinet regarding the LEP Funding and possibly contact our MP for support. All agreed. Action: LWT to contact Cllr White.
- Although all members have no objection to Fieldside Nursery proposed expansion, it was agreed that a site visit would be benefit the Parish to make constructive observations. Site visit to take place by this week.
